	Intermediate Outcomes	Mid-term outcomes that are anticipated to occur within months or a few years of the intervention. Intermediate outcomes can include changes in: • Actions • Behaviors • Practices • Policies • Decisions • Social actions
	Long-Term Outcomes	Outcomes that are intended to occur in the far future – usually years or decades after the intervention has taken place. Long-Term Outcomes can include changes in: • Morbidity • Mortality • Systems • Social contexts • Environmental characteristics
